Dear Parents

We have almost reached the end of the school year! This will be the final Signpost this term.

All children have now spent time in their new classes, and are very excited about moving up in September.

We have two new teachers joining our team in the new term, Miss Plumtree (who will be teaching Pink Class) and Mrs Dawson (who will be the teacher in Purple Class). They have both been into school and met the children, and are looking forward to the new school year. Miss Hart returned from maternity leave on

Monday and is teaching Purple Class – she feels as though she has never been away! Mrs Fields will return next Monday.

At the end of this term we will be saying goodbye to Mrs Elliott-Gregory and Mrs Everitt. Mrs Elliott-Gregory has been part a valued member of our school community for a number of years and we wish her every success in her new school. Although Mrs Everitt has only been with us since January she has become part of the team. She leaves us to return to spending time with her grandchildren and enjoying her hobbies. One of our Reception Teaching Assistants, Mrs Green, will be returning to a supply role from September after supporting Yellow Class for the last few weeks. I would like to thank all three members of staff for their hard work and commitment to the children in our school and wish them all the best for the future.

Attached to this Signpost is a sponsor form for our Sponsored Walk, which will take place next Thursday afternoon. Due to the current building work, this will be a shorter circuit this year; children will walk laps of the school playing field. Children are invited to wear fancy dress (any of their choosing!) or bright colours to school on Thursday to make the walk as colourful as possible. Infants and Juniors will be walking together and, as we won't have as much space as in previous years, we ask that parents do not join us on this occasion.

Our Parent Sharing sessions take place next week. These give you the opportunity to come into your child's class and look at some of the learning that has taken place over the term, and join in some of the fun! Times are:

- Reception 9.00 – 9.30am Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July
- Year One 3.00 – 3.30pm Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July
- Year Two Immediately following class productions on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday

From the start of the new term we will be offering an After School Club for those children whose parents are unable to collect them at the earlier finishing time of 3.10pm. The Club will operate from 3.10 – 3.30pm daily and will initially be free of charge. In order to make arrangements for staffing of the service, places must be booked by 12 noon on Thursday for the following week. Once we know numbers, we will inform parents where children should be collected from. Booking forms are available on the website (After School Club) or from the School Office and can be emailed to us or brought to the Office. Parents requiring this service from the very start of term should complete the booking forms and return them to us by next Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> July.

Over the summer holidays there are a number of building projects taking place on the school site. The new pre-school building should be completed and the old one removed. The pre-school team are looking forward to moving into their new premises! There will be some classroom remodelling in the Junior building. On our side of the site, the main playground is being renovated, along with part of the area alongside the hall and classrooms. Due to the work being carried out, we are unable to host as many holiday activities on site as usual. These should return in October half term.

School closes for the summer holiday on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> July at 3.30pm. On behalf of the entire team I would like to thank you for your continued support with events, assemblies, fundraisers and Parent Sharing sessions, and also for working with us to give your children a great learning experience.

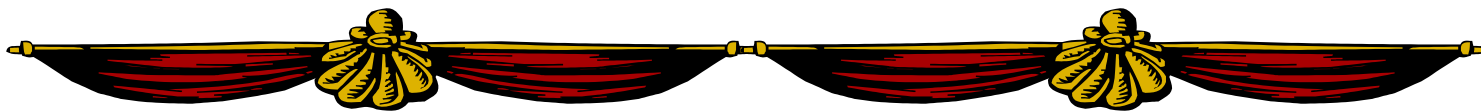
