Dear Parents and Carers

Children in all classes were really delighted that you were able to join them in their Parent Sharing sessions this week. Therefore, whilst this facility will continue to operate for those children affected by the original changes as they move through the academies, it does not form part of our childcare provision for all pupils.

When we return from our half term break, Miss Wood and Mrs Raper are swapping classes, so Miss Wood will be working with Year 2 in Pink class, and Mrs Raper with children in Yellow class.

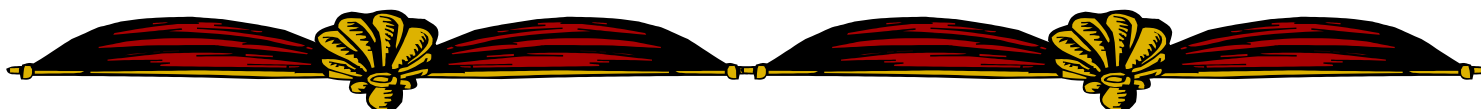
