Dear Parents and Carers

Huge thanks to everyone who supported our Summer Fair last Friday. It was great to see all the stalls and games so busy and children, parents and grandparents enjoying the fun. Over £1000 was raised for school funds. Our Sports Day yesterday was also a success – the rain stayed away and the children enjoyed competing in the games. Our champions were Yellow team with 309 points – well done!

It has been a particularly busy week for children in Year 2. On Wednesday, joined by emotional families and friends they filled St Peter's Church to celebrate the marriage of three couples, one from each class. All the children had important roles to play, and I am sure it is an event they will remember for years to come.

We have less than three weeks until the summer holiday, and there's a lot to fit in! Reception are visiting The Deep, Year One have their Carnival Day and children in Year Two will mark the end of their time in the Infants with a special production of Pirates vs Mermaids. We also have our sponsored walk – sponsor forms have been sent out today.

We are now well into our transition arrangements for next year; children in Reception and Year One have spent two afternoons in their new classrooms, and children in Year two have met some of the Year Three staff and had lunch at the juniors with the Year Three children. This is how it should work:

- 3pm parents of children in **Reception and Year 1** collect your child from their usual classroom. Your child will show you to their new classroom, where you will be able to meet their teacher.
- Parents of children in **Year 2** should collect your child at the usual hometime (3.10pm) from the hall.

On **Friday 8th July**, parents of children in **Year 2** may collect their child at **2pm** to visit their new classrooms in the Juniors. Children should be collected from the grassed area in front of the school office, or from the hall (via the office) if it is raining and may be taken home after visiting the Juniors.

As you will have noticed, our outdoor classroom is almost finished. Huge thanks must go to John and his team of students from GIFHE for all their hard work in installing it.

As we approach the end of term, there will be a few letters and documents finding their way to you. Next week you will receive your child's report, along with a short questionnaire regarding the format. With the report will be your child's attendance record for the year and their attainment against end of year expectations. On the final day of term, we are offering parents the opportunity to collect their children early. A letter with the details and a response slip has been sent home today, so please check book bags!

The 100% attendance sticker and certificate was awarded to Red Class this week.

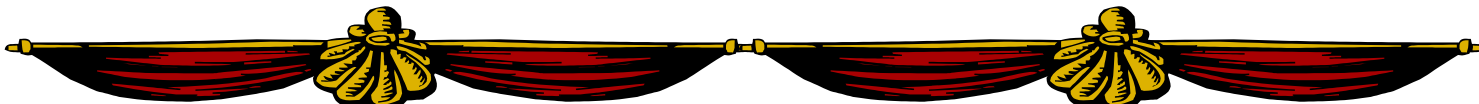

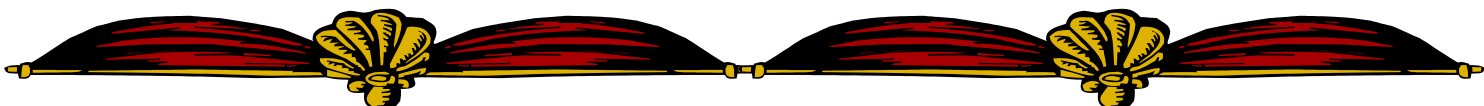
