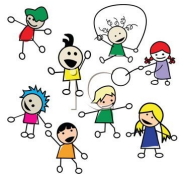

Times Tables — Due to the children's success we are continuing our Superheroes Times Table challenge focussing on the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. This term we are also learning the related division facts for e.g $2 \times 6 = 12$, $6 \times 2 = 12$, $12 \div 2 = 6$, $12 \div 6 = 2$.

Below are some of the things the Year Two children will be learning about this term.

In Literacy:

To write for different purposes, using sentences of different forms including statements, commands, exclamations and questions.

To use capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks in sentences.

To recognise adverbs, nouns, verbs and adjectives in sentences.

To add detail to our writing by using adjectives to describe.

In Maths:

To recall the number of seconds in a minute, minutes in an hour and hours in a day,

To tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour

To measure using standard units for mass, capacity, length, height and temperature.

In our topic work:

To Identify the basic needs of animals and humans for survival, including good nutrition and regular exercise.

To describe the life cycles of some common animals and humans.

To compare the living things in familiar habitats with the living things in a less familiar habitat.
