### **HARDY'S ROAD/CHICHESTER ROAD/LINKS ROAD – PROPOSED TRO CHANGES TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

Engie acting on behalf of North East Lincolnshire Council have undertaken a borough wide review of parking restrictions around local schools. As part of this work there are plans to make alterations to existing restrictions on Hardy's Road as well as introduce new restrictions at the junction with Links Road. These changes aim to better control the parking and improve visibility at the busy junctions in the area, during school pick-up/drop off times. A plan highlighting the extent of the restrictions is attached (**TR-18-11B**).

The proposed School Keep Clear marking ensures that drivers do not park immediately outside the school, in proximity to vehicular and pedestrian entrances. This helps to maintain suitable visibility for passing drivers, allowing those leaving the school to see motorists and vice versa, thus improving road safety. The double yellow line restrictions at Links Road will ensure a safer crossing point for pedestrians as well as improve visibility, especially during the hours of darkness.
