Our Learning Journey

In our topic we shall be:

- *making a circuit to light a bulb
- *looking at the work of Patrick Heron
- *discovering hot and cold places in the world
- *naming the continents of the world
- *researching why Captain Cook and Grace Darling are famous
- *finding out why lighthouses were invented and the work of the RNLI

In our Literacy we shall be:

- *writing different types of sentences (exclamation, question, command, statement)
- *using a range of punctuation accurately such as full stops, commas, exclamation marks, question marks and apostrophes
- *writing a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and exploring their features

In our Maths learning we shall be:

- *to name and recognise the properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- *exploring more formal methods to solve addition and subtraction calculations
- *constructing and interpreting tally charts and pictograms
- *naming fractions ($\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$) and finding fractions of shapes, lengths and numbers
